- Must be early in their careers (≤8 years), such as PhD or MD students, postdocs, scientists, clinical fellows, or residents, junior faculty without funding
- Conducting basic or clinical research relevant to the symposium theme;
- Should be the first author on an abstract submitted to the ISBRA2018;
- Upon selection, should register for the congress and present a poster and/or short oral summary.
- Cannot be supported by other travel award mechanism.
