Instructions for Oral Presenters

A. Length of General Presentation

Presentation 7 minutes, Discussion 3 minutes, Total: 10 minutes

Designated Speakers: The details provided to those who concerned.

A yellow lamp will be on 1 minute before the end of the presentation. A red lamp will mark the end of the presentation.

B. Equipment: Computers

OS: Windows 7 or later

Application: Microsoft Office PowerPoint ver.2007 or later

C. PC Data Preview Center

All speakers are requested to come to the PC Data Preview Center in the facility at least 60 minutes prior to the presentation time to verify if the data functions properly on the equipment provided.

When you are scheduled to make presentation in the early hours on 1st or 2nd October, it is recommended to register the data the day before the presentation.

All presentation data will be loaded onto a server at the PC Data Preview Center and distributed to an appropriate session room at an appropriate time via a LAN. Copied files will be completely deleted by the staff after the congress.

D. PowerPoint Presentation

- Bring your presentation on a Windows readable USB flash drive or CD-ROM. In case you use
 movie files, it is recommended to use your own laptop and make sure that the data is applicable to
 Windows Media Player.
- Make sure that you close or "finalize" your presentation file when create a CD. If you omit this step, you cannot access the CD from any other computer.
- Only the standard fonts (e.g., Times Roman, Helvetica, Arial, Times New Roman) are accepted
 for your presentation file, and unusual fonts may not be displayed properly on the computers in
 session rooms.
- Include any external files utilized e.g. movie files in the same folder as your presentation. Copy the entire folder to the USB flash drive or CD-ROM.
- Please name the file as: "Program no. (or session name)_presenter name. ppt (If PowerPoint2010/2007,.pptx)"
- In order to avoid virus infection, please scan your data with updated anti-virus software beforehand.
- Users of Macintosh Computers should bring their own Macintosh since there would be technical issues that can arise when PowerPoint files created on a Macintosh run on a Windows PC.



E. Laptops

- Speakers using their own laptops MUST HAVE a VGA D-sub 15pin female output. Special video output cable is required for some laptops to use the D-sub 15pin to connect to external monitors and data projectors. Please note that we are not equipped with that special cable and you must bring it in case it is necessary. The laptop output resolution should be no more than XGA (1024 x 768). The higher resolutions than the native resolution (1024 x 768) would possibly lose some information or not projectby forcing the data projector into a compression mode.
- Please name the file as: "Program no. (or session name)_presenter name. ppt (If PowerPoint2010/2007,.pptx)" and save it to the desktop or create a shortcut on the desktop.
- You should have your data backed up in case of computer trouble.
- Please turn off the screen-saver or energy saving mode beforehand.
- After checked the presentation at the PC Data Preview Center, you are asked to take your laptop to the presentation room by yourself and hand it to the operation desk located on the left side of the podium. After the presentation, please do not forget to receive your laptop.

Presentation: 4 minutes, Discussion: 2 minutes, Total: 6 minutes



3. Instructions for Chairpersons

- 1. Chairpersons for oral sessions are asked to be in their session room no later than 15 minutes prior to the start of the session. Chairpersons should make every effort to maintain the time schedule in cooperation with the time keeper, and give warnings, if needed, to the speakers.
- 2. Chairpersons for the poster sessions should visit the chairperson reception desk in the poster session room no later than 20 minutes before the discussion time, and then wait at their poster panels no later than 10 minutes before the start.
