8 awards for young scientists in the U.S. with legal status for at least one year

- Supported by NIAAA R13 AA020691

5 awards for young scientists from other nations

- Supported by endowment funds of Southern California Research Center for ALPD and Cirrhosis

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be early in their careers (≤ 8 years), such as PhD or MD students, postdocs, scientists, clinical fellows, or residents, junior faculty without funding
- Conducting basic or clinical research relevant to the symposium theme;
- Should be the first author on an abstract submitted to the ISBRA2018;
- Upon selection, should register for the congress and present a poster and/or short oral summary.
- Cannot be supported by other travel award mechanism.

- Indicate on an abstract that it is for **ISALPD/C travel award application**.
- Submit an abstract under “Alcohol-Induced Organ Damage” category per the ISBRA2018 instructions:

Selection will be made on a competitive basis and awardees will be notified by June 1, 2018. Awards are provided via reimbursement of travel costs after submission of receipts following the Congress.
