

It switches over to the file upload screen.


Upload Procedure 2



This is the file upload screen.

Uploading to the server can begin, by dragging and dropping files and folders within the blue dashed frame.

Upload Procedure 3



The upload status of the registered file can be checked.

.mp3 and .mp4 ,**.pdf** files can be registered.

If there is an upload error, a cross [X] mark will be added on the file and the reason for the Error is displayed in the red frame.

(In the image, an error that does not support .pptx,.png, and .jpg image files is displayed.)

After registration, click the back button on the upper right or the HOME button on the upper left To return to the list screen.

You can delete files by clicking the trash can icon from the action icons. For batch deletion, click the check box to the left of the file name. A confirmation message will be displayed when you click the “Delete” button that lights up in blue. Press the OK button to delete the file from the server. (Deleted files are not temporarily stored, so it is recommended to save them locally.)
