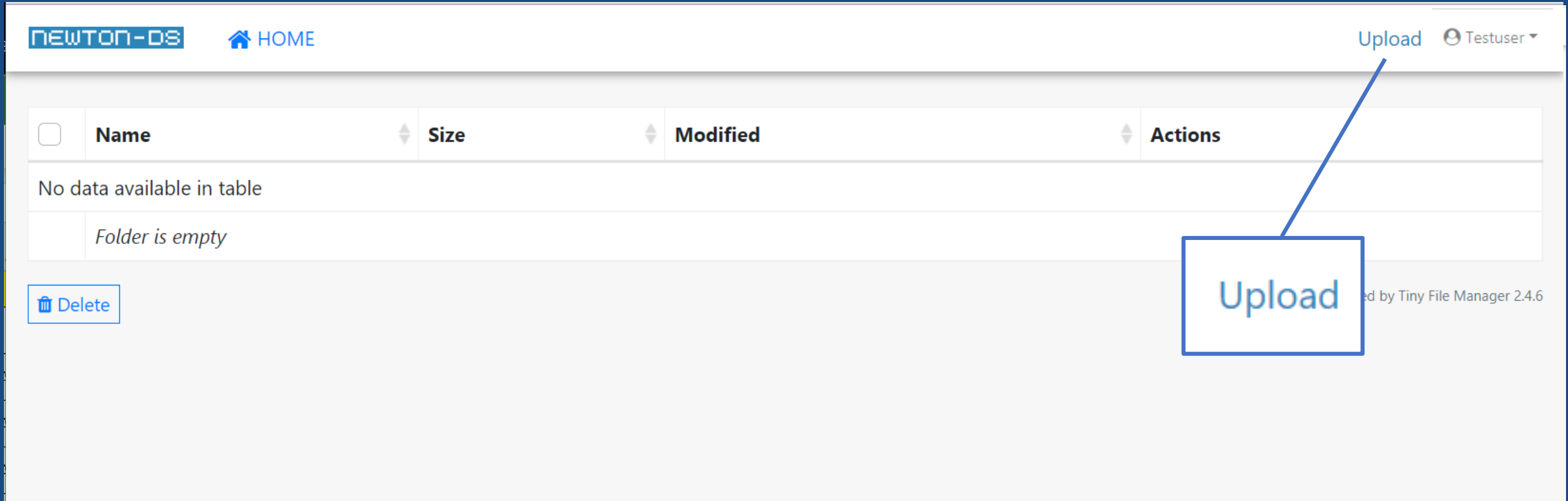


If the login is successful, the uploaded file list screen will be displayed.

Upload Procedure 2

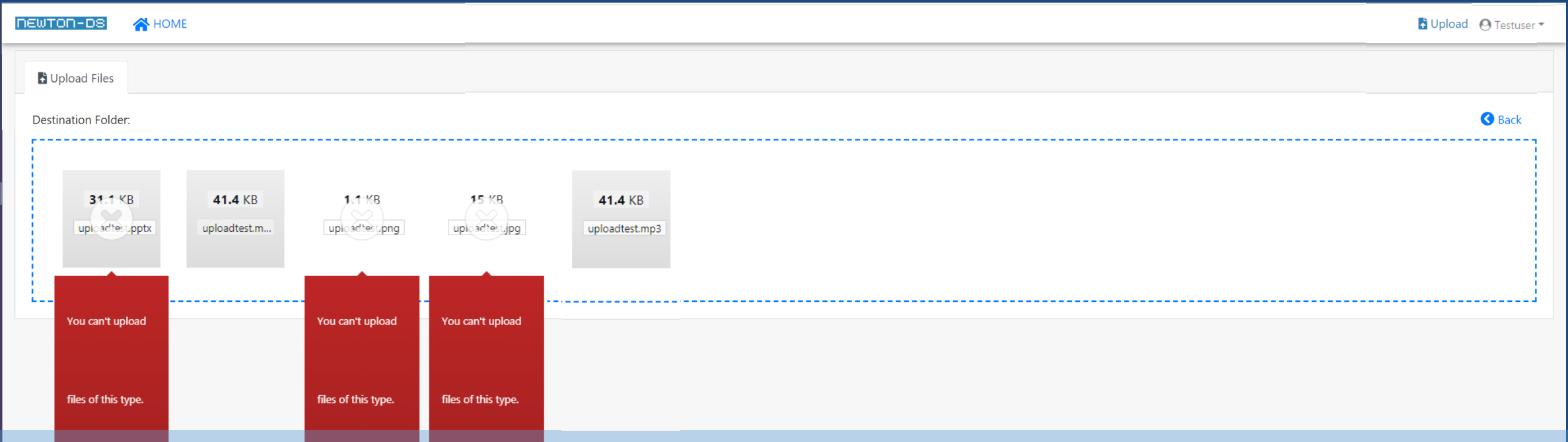

.mp3 and .mp4 ,.pdf files can be registered.
















If there is an upload error, a cross [X] mark will be added on the file and the reason for the Error is displayed in the red frame.

You can delete files by clicking the trash can icon from the action icons.
For batch deletion, click the check box to the left of the file name.
A confirmation message will be displayed when you click the “Delete” button that lights up in blue. Press the OK button to delete the file from the server.
(Deleted files are not temporarily stored, so it is recommended to save them locally.)
