Welcome Message

The 109th Annual Meeting of the Japanese Urological Association will be held at Pacifico Yokohama from Monday, April 26 to Thursday, April 29, 2021. It is a great honor for my department and the Keio Urology Alumni Association to be entrusted with holding this Annual Meeting.

As the theme of the 109th Annual Meeting, we have chosen "Cosmos Inside of Urology – Diverse and Profound Expertise." Urology encompasses an exceptionally wide range of conditions, ranging from cancer, reproductive medicine, renal transplantation, lithiasis, erectile dysfunction in men, urinary incontinence in women, and congenital disorders, and these all require a high degree of specialization. In each specialist area, urologists carry out every task from diagnosis to treatment, and their patients are of both sexes and all ages from infants to the elderly. A single course of treatment may include both drug therapy and surgery. Device development and basic research are also underway, making urology an exceptionally diverse calling. Under these circumstances, it is not surprising that we urologists ourselves are also a highly varied group in terms of skills, attributes, and personalities. As we are also engaged in both reproductive medicine, which concerns the birth of new life, and the end-stage treatment of cancer patients, the overall values of our contemporary society, including its social, religious, cultural, and economic aspects, are naturally reflected in the medical care we provide. This Annual Meeting will emphasize urology's unparalleled combination of specialization and diversity, both conveying to our younger colleagues the worldview that has emerged as a consequence and giving rise to new worldviews by posing the question "What is urology?" and building a platform on which to consider its future direction.

The actual program will include a broad variety of up-to-date educational lectures, symposia, and workshops in the current specialist fields within urology, as well as interdisciplinary themes beyond the boundaries of our own area. We are also planning to hold not only joint sessions with the AUA/EAU, but also the first ever joint sessions with the Society of Genitourinary Reconstructive Surgeons (GURS) and the 58th Annual Congress of the Japanese Society of Pediatric Surgeons, which is being held at the same time in Pacifico Yokohama North. As well as focusing the programs in each specialist area so as to give each day a specific theme, we are grouping related events together and making a range of other efforts to ensure that the meeting is as useful as possible for participants. To overcome the limitations of our medicine-based worldview, the program will incorporate a number of Special Lectures, Invited Lectures, and "Views from the Cosmos" Lectures given by speakers in a range of different non-medical fields including art, literature, religion, and economics, and I hope that these four days will leave a lasting impression on everyone who takes part.

I look forward to receiving a large number of abstract submissions and to welcoming as many as possible of you there.
