


Patient-Safety Malpractice Claims of Elderly Patients in Connection with In and Outpatient Care and Recommended Prevention Measures

Annie needs a hip replacement!


..... at the age of 93



- Admission to a clinic that is specialized in endoprosthetics
- Surgery and anesthesia planning
- Admission on the day before surgery and planning of discharge
- Fast track surgery
- Monitoring in the recovery room including delirium prophylaxis
- Nursing care including the start of walking exercises on the 1st day after surgery
- Professional wound care and decubitus prophylaxis
- Discharge on the 7th day after surgery and admission to rehab
- Individual exercises which are appropriate to her age
- End of rehab on the 21st day after hip replacement
