The Global Alliance for Genomics and Health (GA4GH) is an international not-for-profit alliance that aims to unlock the power of genomic data to benefit human health. With the goal of expanding responsible, voluntary, and secure genomic data use, GA4GH defines standard methods for data exchange as well as for describing genomic information and associated clinical information. GA4GH also promotes global harmonisation of ethical frameworks and consent procedures for data sharing. In this forum, delegates from GA4GH will review the activities of GA4GH and introduce Australia's efforts to integrate genomic medicine into healthcare nationally, including implementation of GA4GH standards and international collaborations. We will also introduce some of the nationwide genome-related projects in the Asian region, including Japan, and promote discussion for future cooperation.
