

Dr. Eugene Grossi has been a surgeon at NYU Langone Health for the past four decades, having trained under Dr. Frank Spencer. He is the inaugural Steven B. Colvin Cardiothoracic Surgery Professor of Cardiothoracic Surgery and the Program Director for the Thoracic Surgery Residency in the NYU School of Medicine. In addition to practicing in the NYU Dr. Grossi is chief of cardiothoracic surgery at the New York Harbor Veterans' Administration Hospital.

Dr. Grossi has published with greater than 300 peer reviewed manuscripts, and have been on the editorial board of the Annals of Thoracic Surgery, and currently the Journal of Thoracic and Cardiovascular Surgery. Dr. Grossi is currently the Adult editor of the Seminars in Thoracic and Cardiovascular Surgery. His current areas of study include LV reshaping, minimally invasive valve surgery and the use of artificial intelligence techniques for surgical Quality Analysis. His clinical practice is split between cardiothoracic surgery at the Veterans' Administration and a highly specialized robotic mitral valve repair practice with his colleague Dr. Loulmet at the NYU Langone Medical Center.
