The Kikumasamune Sake Museum is a historical facility located in Nada-Gogo, Kobe, Japan's premier sake-brewing district. It exhibits the history of Kikumasamune, founded in 1659, and the "Nada Sake Brewing Tools," a nationally designated Important Tangible Folk Cultural Property, conveying the charm of traditional Kimoto-style brewing to the present day. Inside the museum, you can deeply learn about the sake brewing process, making it a popular tourist spot where you can also enjoy tasting limited-edition sake and shopping.
