## Disclosure of Conflict of Interest at the Japanese Society of Medical Oncology 2018 Annual Meeting

The presenter (the first author) and the principal investigator must disclose the name of a company or for-profit organization related to COI: the following items (1) to (8) exceeding separately stipulated criteria, and (9), (10) if met. The subjected period is from January 1, 2015- December 31, 2017.

- (1) Position as an officer or advisor of a company or for-profit organization
  - > ¥1,000,000/year
- (2) Ownership of stock
  - > 10%
- (3) Patent royalties or licensing fees from a company or for-profit organization
  - > ¥1,000,000/year
- (4) Honoraria (such as lecture fees) from a company or for-profit organization paid as compensation for the time or labor of a researcher engaged for conference attendance (presentation)
  - > ¥500,000/year
- (5) Manuscript fees paid by a company or for-profit organization as compensation for writing for a pamphlet or other publication
  - > ¥500,000/year
- (6) Research funding provided by a company or for-profit organization
  - > ¥1,000,000/year
- (7) Advisory fees or remuneration paid by either a company or a for-profit organization in exchange for testimony in a lawsuit
  - > ¥1,000,000/year
- (8) Other remuneration (travel, gifts, or other in-kind payments not directly related to research > ¥50,000/year
- (9) Acceptance of researchers from a company or for-profit organization
- (10) Representative of an organization endowed by a company or for-profit organization
